BOE convened the Social Studies Advisory Committee (SSAC) in July 2020 for purposes of drafting guiding principles and making recommendations for BOE and SSOE; final guiding principles were adopted in December 2020. OSSE convened the Technical Writing Committee (TWC) in February 2021 to review and revise social studies standards. OSSE released the current revised draft of updated social studies standards in December 2022; ublic comment on the revised standards is open through Jan. 30, 2023 at 5pm EST. The new standards are to be implemented in DC public schools by the 2023-24 school year.
